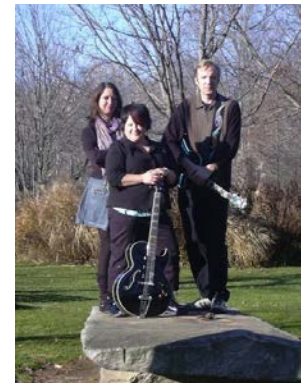

Penguin Plunge - 8:45 In the Pool

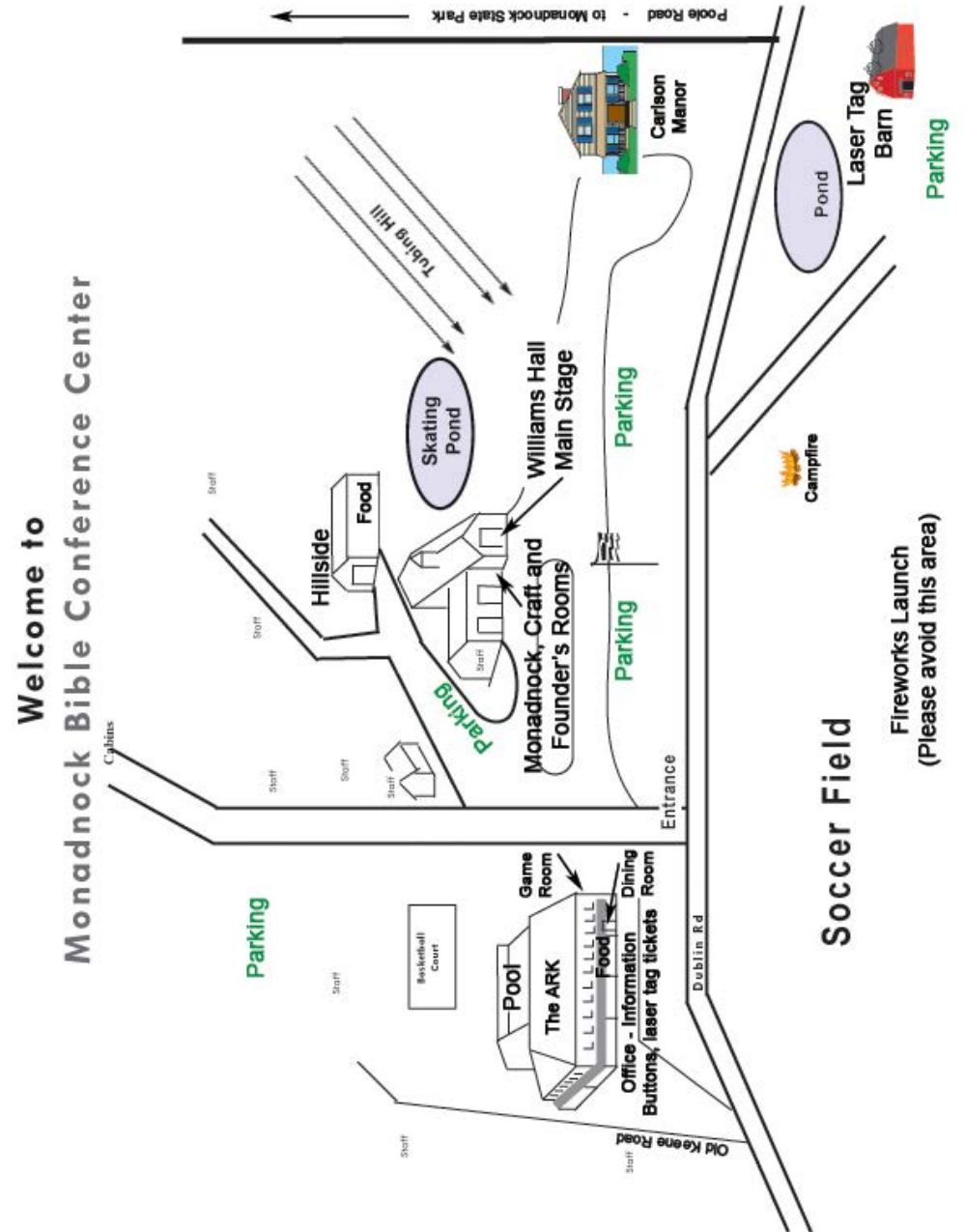
